1st Place = \$400.00 2nd Place = \$250.00 3rd Place = \$100.00

- 1). All entries must be received by Friday January 18, 2019. The Schedule of Performances will be posted on our website 10 days after the deadline. Performers must check-in 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the night's competition.
- 2). Entry Fee: Submitted with the Official Entry Form; individual \$25.00/group \$35.00 to be paid by either check or money order with the performer name/group name in memo. Late Entry Fee's will be accepted 7 days prior to the first competition night for an additional \$50.00.
- 3). Rural Tri-State's Got Talent will begin Tuesday February 5, 2019. All competition dates will be held on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. Time of performances TBD.
- 4). Performers may compete in a maximum of two (2) acts, not to exceed one individual performance.
- 5). Soft background vocals will be allowed, if approved by committee, on any taped accompaniment used by a vocal act. No taps or tap effects are allowed on a taped recording used by a dancer. If an instrumental solo, no instrument of the same nature may be used for accompaniment. The talent performed **MUST** be clearly different from any assisting used during the performance.
- 6). The size of the stage area is 24' X 20'. Electrical outlets, sound system, microphone and a cassette stereo system will be furnished if needed. Please notify the Talent Contest Chairman if you have any special needs.
- 7). **Your act can last no longer than five (5) minutes.** Timing begins when your music starts or you speak to the audience or you begin performing. Timing stops when your performance is fully completed. There will be a point deduction after 5 minutes and the act will be disqualified if it is longer than six (6) minutes. This will be determined by the Official Timer. **Setup time is limited to 10 minutes.**
- 8). There will be three (3) Official Judges using the below categories for scoring:

Talent
Entertainment/Showmanship
Audience Appeal
Stage Appearance / Props & Costuming
Originality

Each night there will be a designated tie breaker judge present and members of the contest committee.
